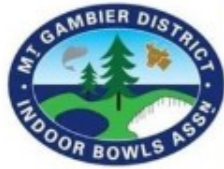

USEFUL INFORMATION ON KIMOCHIS



Kimochis look like toys, but they are actually tools. Communication tools. Kimochis teaches our students the very important skills that are necessary for Quality Relationships. Like other life skills these must be learnt and developed. Everyone's development is different and some students might need more assistance than others in terms of social and emotional development.

The Kimochis educational program is built upon sound research and theories of child development and social emotional learning. When we boil down the research and get to the basics of what is necessary for success and happiness in life, it's all about relationships.

Do you know how to make and keep friends? Can you build and maintain good strong relationships? Can you relate to others? Can you work with others? How do others see you? Can you express your true feelings in ways that people want to listen? The research is clear. Strong relationships and communication skills, self-awareness, empathy, and resilience are key indicators for emotional wellness and "success" for academically achieving in all areas life, from preschool through adulthood.

These Kimochis tools can be used to build the strong relationship skills which help us:

- make and keep friends on the playground
- successfully work on group projects in the classroom
- navigate the social media landscape as a teen
- avoid the temptations and pitfalls of alcohol and drug use and abuse
- network with peers to land an interview and a job
- work well with others
- have healthy adult relationships

Our Pastoral Care Worker Belinda Tilley is competent and experienced in being able to deliver Social Emotional Learning in schools in classrooms, small groups and through individual support. Belinda is onsite at Yahl PS on Tuesday Afternoon's and all day Wednesday. Please encourage your child to seek her out if they need some pastoral /wellbeing support.
